The practice first introduced VetIMPRESS for foot trimming and mobility scoring services over 4 years ago. Having quickly realised the benefits, Delaware Veterinary Group now use the platform across the farm animal team for routine fertility visits, clinical recording, diary management, billing, Antimicrobial Usage (AMU) and vet spend reporting.

VetIMPRESS enables Delaware Veterinary Group to access data at farm and animal level. Owain explains: "VetIMPRESS provides a central place where all information is collected and reports are generated. We initially used the tool for our lameness services but two or three years ago I started using it for fertility visits, recording information and gaining insights about the state of the cow. There was a real need for it, we were dealing with many data sources and trying to integrate them all."

"With VetIMPRESS our farm clients receive a more precise service from us as vets; we are making decisions based on data and doing the right interventions at the right time. A good example of this is identifying animals that may not be economically viable to continue in the herd. Having insight that an animal is too old or too far in a lactation to continue is now readily available to us before we start on an expensive treatment program for the farmer.
