 - Prioritising the backlog to ensure the delivery of value to stakeholders, and the communication of planned release dates.
 - Negotiating with stakeholders to ensure prioritisation is clearly understood and meets business requirements
 - Reacting to urgent feedback and defect reports to determine when adjustments should be made to planned work to accommodate remedial work.
- Facilitating development sprints, including working with the development team to clarify requirements, gather estimates and participate in planning and review meetings.
- Delivering product demos to stakeholders on a regular basis to showcase new features and improvements.
- Be the voice of the customer and represent their interests in internal meetings
- Act as an ambassador for the product, both internally and externally
- Follow developments within the agriculture sector, particularly related to veterinary practices and animal welfare issues. Stay up-to-date with competitor developments in the sector. Keep abreast of the latest best practices in agile software development and product management.
